School of Professional Education and Executive Development, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU SPEED) in collaboration with the Hong Kong Mediation Centre (HKMC) is now offering the following course.

Advanced Mediation Course

Mediation is an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process of voluntary participation in nature that aims at building consensus and agreement through a neutral third party acting as facilitator or catalyst for effective communication, issues clarification and options generation. There are many success stories of resolving disputes by mediation without the need of going to court. The disputants not only save their tremendous amount of time and money on litigation, but also the precious relationship between them. This course gives a brief account of the fundamental framework on how mediation works, including its basic principles, procedures and techniques, and the major legal issues behind the scene. The fundamental framework provides an organised and systematic basis to conduct general-purpose mediations, such as community or commercial mediations, aiming at a win-win settlement to the benefit of and acceptable to both the parties in dispute.

Assessment Method(s)	 Settlement agreement drafting assessment (25%); and End of course assessment (75%)

Certification	By PolyU SPEED: 1. Certificate of Attainment will be issued to students with the attendance rate of 100% and scoring of at least 60% in each of the course assessment. 2. Certificate of Attendance will be issued to students with the attendance rate of 100% but without passing all the assessments. By HKMC: 1. Certificate will be issued to students with the attendance rate of 100% and scoring of at least 60% in each of the course assessment.
Remark(s)	 Students are expected to make effort in coping with the required workload. Study materials will mainly be in English. This course is pending for accreditation by the Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Limited (HKMAAL), a mediation accreditation body in Hong Kong to be formally established in early 2013. The course requirements have been revised according to the criteria proposed by HKMAAL (with an attendance rate of 100% and scoring of at least 60% in each of the course assessment). Hong Kong Mediation Centre will provide further details about accreditation in due course, by the end of this course.
