Introduction

Established in 2001 under the auspices of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) is a self-financed post-secondary institution which offers 35 Associate Degree (AD) and Higher Diploma (HD) programmes – spanning arts, science, social sciences, business as well as the two specialised areas of design and health care – for senior secondary school leavers. HKCC boasts two campuses – the Hung Hom Bay Campus and the West Kowloon Campus. With a floor area totalling over 57,000 square metres, the two dedicated campuses offer students an ideal study environment equipped with state-of-the-art facilities. Classes of all HKCC programmes are conducted on the two campuses. Since its establishment, HKCC has helped over 11,300 of its graduates articulate into bachelor's degree programmes.

Aims and Objectives

The programmes of HKCC provide students with a holistic post-secondary education for further studies or career development.

Quality Assurance

The AD / HD programmes of HKCC follow the common descriptors of the Education Bureau. They are accredited and approved by the PolyU Senate. Successful completion of HKCC AD/HD programmes will lead to PolyU-HKCC awards.

Credit-based System

Programmes offered by HKCC are credit-based. By providing students with greater flexibility in their selection of subjects and pace of study, such a system has the merit of being more responsive to the changing needs of students and society. The system also facilitates credit transfers to other programmes or from other recognised institutions.

Campus Life and Facilities

On the campuses in Hung Hom Bay and West Kowloon, HKCC students can enjoy comprehensive teaching and learning facilities including lecture theatres and classrooms, libraries, computer centres, multi-purpose halls, language laboratories, design studios, science laboratory, healthcare laboratory, cafeteria, etc. Students can also use the Pao Yue-kong Library and sports venues on the PolyU Main Campus.

Student Development Activities

The Student Development Committee of HKCC organises a wide range of co-curricular activities including complementary studies and physical education programmes so as to enhance the all-round development of students, enrich their campus life and provide them with a unique learning experience. The Committee also hosts activities to assist students in their further studies and career development. The HKCC Students' Union, along with about 30 clubs and societies, also organises a wide array of interesting and learning-enriching activities for fellow students.

Articulation Opportunities

HKCC graduates can apply for entrance into local or overseas universities, especially those programmes offered by PolyU academic departments, where HKCC graduates may be eligible for credit exemptions. Besides, HKCC graduates can also enjoy the "2+2" seamless articulation between HKCC and SPEED. HKCC students, with a conditional offer given by SPEED upon joining HKCC, can enrol on SPEED's 2-year full-time honours top-up degree programmes leading to PolyU-Speed awards upon successful completion of AD / HD programmes.

Over the past ten years, the average articulation rate of HKCC graduates has consistently been over 70% while in 2012, it reached 83%.

Financial Assistance

Students may apply for the Government's Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP) or Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Post-secondary Students (NLSPS). They may also apply for Student Travel Subsidy.
